






Tutorials were conducted by 9 faculty members and 1 Teaching assistants. Tutorial clients include graduate students, undergraduate students, research students, faculty members and admin staff.

More than 14 Faculties and Schools are using the Mei-Writing Tutorial Services (about 65% from Humanities and 35% from Sciences).

Each tutorial session lasts 45 minutes.

Our Service Numbers continue to grow and the demand exceeds far beyond the capacities of the Department.
