

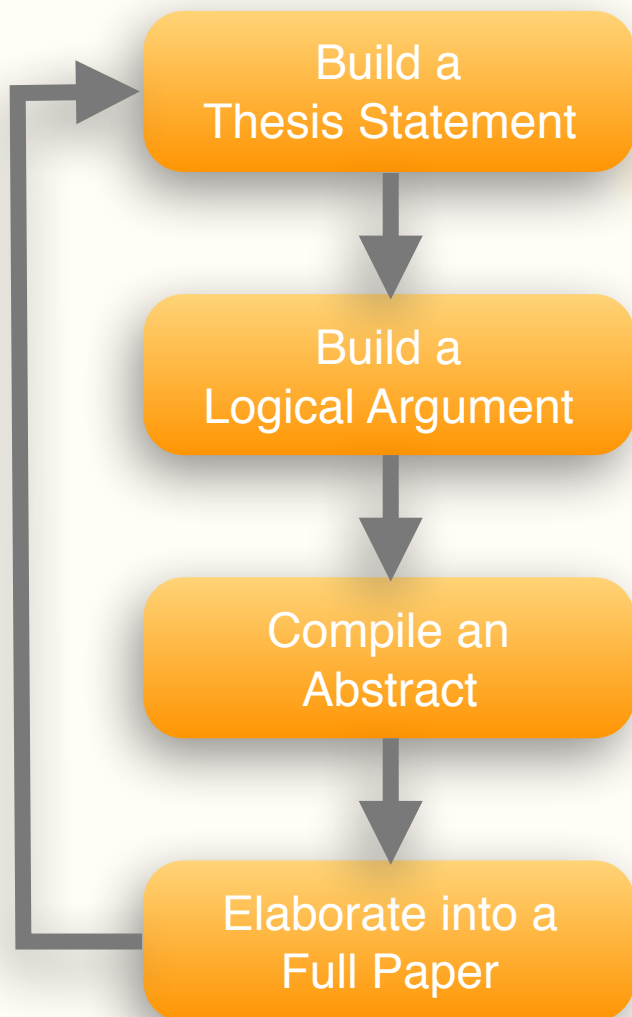

Research Skills A-1: Research Writing and Logical Thinking Skills I (Eng)
Instructor: Paul W. L. Lai, Day/Period: Tue/3rd per

This course aims to help you publish your paper by helping you develop a clear research idea and a convincing logical argument for the idea.

Research Skills B-1: Fundamentals of Academic Writing (Eng)

Instructor: Chad Nilep, Day/Period: Fri/4th per

Participants discuss international norms of logic and form for academic writing. You will deliver one oral presentation and write one abstract.

Research Skills B-3: Elements of Academic Writing I (Eng)

Focus your research by improving your thesis, your plan to argue it and your ability to effectively advertise it for conferences.

Research Skills C-1: Practical Presentation Skills (Eng)

Research Skills C-3: Academic Presentation Design (Eng)
